

Yotsee

Objective: Score the most points by rolling five dice to make specific combinations.

Setup:

- 5 dice
- Score sheet
- Pencil or pen
- Dice cup (optional)

Gameplay:

1. On your turn, roll all five dice.
2. You may re-roll any or all dice up to two more times (for a total of 3 rolls).
3. After your final roll, choose one category on your score sheet to fill in.
4. You must fill in one box each turn – even if you score zero points.
5. The game continues until all players have filled every box on their sheet (13 turns per player).

Upper Section:

Category	Description	Score
Aces (Ones)	Sum of 1s rolled	1 point each
Twos	Sum of 2s rolled	2 points each
Threes	Sum of 3s rolled	3 points each
Fours	Sum of 4s rolled	4 points each
Fives	Sum of 5s rolled	5 points each
Sixes	Sum of 6s rolled	6 points each
Bonus	If upper total ≥ 63	+35 points

Lower Section:

Category	Description	Score
3 of a Kind	At least 3 dice the same	Sum of all dice
4 of a Kind	At least 4 dice the same	Sum of all dice
Full House	3 of one number & 2 of another	25 points
Small Straight	4 consecutive numbers (1-2-3-4)	30 points
Large Straight	5 consecutive numbers (2-3-4-5-6)	40 points
Yotsee	All 5 dice the same	50 points

Chance	Any combination	Sum of all dice
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Extra Yotsee Rule:

If you roll another Yotsee after already scoring one, you earn a 100-point bonus and must also score in another category.

End of Game:

Add up all scores. Highest total wins!
